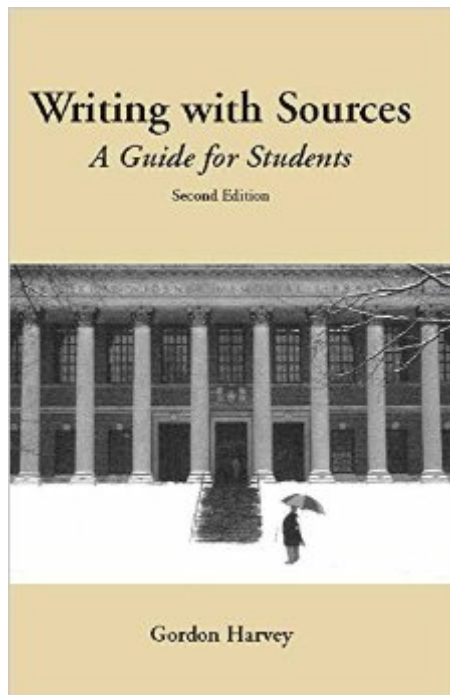


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Writing With Sources: A Guide For Students (Hackett Student Handbooks)
