

Drs. Cruz and Buser have created a handbook for those of us who have been teetering on the edge of incredulity regarding the political choices offered us for our presidential election this November, 2016. The contributors, each of whom wrote a chapter on some aspect of narcissism, resonated with insight and concise predictions for those individuals who disregard expert warnings of unleashing a yet to be measured insanity of a narcissist sitting in the Oval Office beginning January, 2017. Trumplestilskin, one of the chapters reminds me of the effort to warn children of the dangers of sexual predation without scaring the bejesus out of them. Dr. Cruz skillfully spelled out the warnings and explicitly predicted the consequences of falling prey to a collective narcissistic mindset to all who would be receptive to evaluating or re-evaluating their inclinations. Problematic is the likelihood that too few are even aware of their inclinations. Dr. Buser reminded us that complexes can have us rather than the commonly accepted view that all of us have a complex of some variety. Further, collective complexes as a nation, emanating from 9/11, financial crises, unwinnable wars, political deadlock and medical threats worldwide have succeeded in creating cultural complexes within our nation. The Trump Complex, rooted in a John Wayne archetype wearing a white hat gripping the nation has resulted in many who project this super human mythological character onto Trump with the conviction that he will deliver us from all evil. Nancy Swift Furlotti, PhD tapped into a period of my life that even now I am surprised I survived. Her devastating account of living with a narcissist mirrors mine. Clarissa Pinkola Estes, PhD challenges us to "Do Not Lose Heart".
